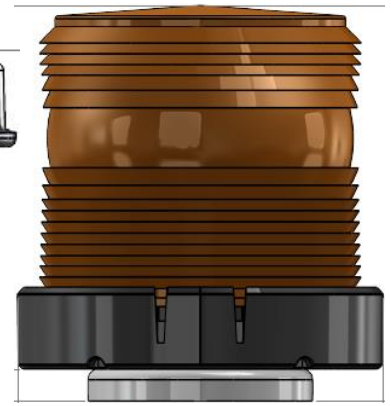




Temporary Mount Eclipse and Beacon with USB-C-PD

The following is a list of recommended practices for the installation and operation of your device.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS COULD RESULT IN DAMAGE TO THE PRODUCT OR VEHICLE AND/OR SERIOUS INJURY.

- Proper installation of this product requires the installer to have a good understanding of automotive electronics, systems, and procedures. You may need to consult a professional for installation.
- SWS Warning Lights Inc. recommends the use of waterproof butt splices and/or connectors for all electrical connections. It is recommended that the use of good dielectric grease be used on all connections where possible.
- SWS Warning Lights Inc. does not recommend leaving a magnetically mounted device on a vehicle while the vehicle is in motion. The owner does so at their own risk.
- If mounting this product requires drilling holes, the installer must be sure that no vehicle components or other vital parts could be damaged by the drilling process. Also, de-burr the holes and remove any metal shards or remnants. Grommets are recommended for all wire holes.
- Do not mount the product close to antennae or radio equipment, as they may cause electromagnetic interference. After installation of the product, it is necessary to test all electronic equipment simultaneously to ensure that they operate free of interference from other components within the vehicle.
- Never power emergency warning equipment from the same circuit or share the same grounding circuit with radio communication equipment.
- Do not install this product or route any wires in the deployment area of your air bag or areas that interfere with the operation of the vehicle. Refer to your vehicle owner's manual for the air bag deployment area and recommended mounting areas for warning lights and other equipment.
- Do not place product near the ear. Temporary deafness or other injury may occur.
- Use only soap and water to clean the product.
- Do not use a pressure washer to clean this product.
- Inspect and operate this product regularly to confirm its proper operation and mounting condition.
- It is recommended that these instructions be stored in a safe place and referred to when performing maintenance and/or reinstallation of this product.
- SWS Warning Lights Inc. and its subsidiaries are not responsible for any damages due to improperly mounted or improperly wired lighting equipment.

Mounting

- For magnetic mount: apply the supplied vinyl magnet cover to the bottom of the magnet.
- For magnetic and vacuum mount: remove any debris (dirt, film, water, etc.) from the magnet and the mounting surface before securing light to the surface.
- Once product is secured, route USB-C-PD cord into the vehicle through the window, **not the door**.
- Ensure the wire is not interfering with visibility, operation of the steering wheel, or other important controls.

Functionality

****Make sure USB-C port has a 30W capacity with power delivery, see compatibility info below****

- Plug the USB-C-PD cord into USB-C-PD port and the light will turn on (may require ignition to be turned on).
- The light emits a quad flash pattern only.

Adapters

Every USB-C-PD product from SWS ships with an included AC adapter to use if required (refer to compatibility chart). A 12V auxiliary port (cig plug) adapter is also available as a separate kit (see part number 96031).

Power Delivery

USB-C-PD (Power Delivery) is a fast-charging technology that allows different voltages and current draw for USB-C devices, allowing them to receive up to 100 Watts of Power. This enables quicker charging times and the ability to power larger devices like warning lights, all through a single, reversible USB-C port.

Trouble Shooting

- Check all connections for breakage or corrosion.
- Check to see if the fuse has blown within the vehicle and if it has, replace with a fuse of same amp rating.
- Check power to the vehicle USB-C-PD plug receptacle.
- Ensure the vehicle's battery is charged and that the charging system is functional.
