



DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND ECONOMIC CORRIDORS REGISTRAR'S EXEMPTION

The Registrar of Motor Vehicle Services of Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors, pursuant to section 114 of Alberta's Vehicle Equipment Regulation (AR 122/2009) (VER), subject to the conditions and restrictions noted below, hereby exempts highway maintenance vehicles from section 24(1) of the VER as it relates to the installation and use of blue flashing lamps.

Conditions:

1. For the purpose of this Registrar's Exemption, a "highway maintenance vehicle" is a vehicle that is used in highway construction, inspection, maintenance or safety investigation.
2. In addition, or as an alternative, to the amber flashing lamps permitted under section 34(1) and (2) of the VER, a highway maintenance vehicle may be equipped with a combination of blue and amber flashing lamps to be operated in accordance with section 34(1) and (2) of the VER.
3. Vehicles must have at least one amber lamp on top of the vehicle, visible from all directions outside the vehicle.
4. If installed for use, blue flashing lamps must be mounted on the vehicle in a rear facing position only.
5. If installed for use, blue flashing lamps on snowplows must be mounted and configured as shown in Appendix A.
6. If installed for use, blue flashing lamps must at all times be operated in tandem with amber flashing lamps. Blue flashing lamps are not authorized for use or installation without amber flashing lamps.
7. All flashing lamps must be compliant with SAE standards as per section 4 of the VER.
8. Flashing lamps must be controlled from inside the vehicle cab and vehicles must be equipped with an indicator inside the vehicle that can be seen by the driver to indicate that the flashing lamps are on.

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9. A person shall not turn on or use the flashing lamps unless the vehicle is being used for highway construction, inspection, maintenance or safety investigation. Use of flashing lamps is prohibited while the vehicle is travelling to or from the site.
10. This Registrar's Exemption cannot be used in conjunction with any other permit or Registrar's Exemption that pertains to the use of white flashing lamps.

This exemption expires on February 29, 2028.

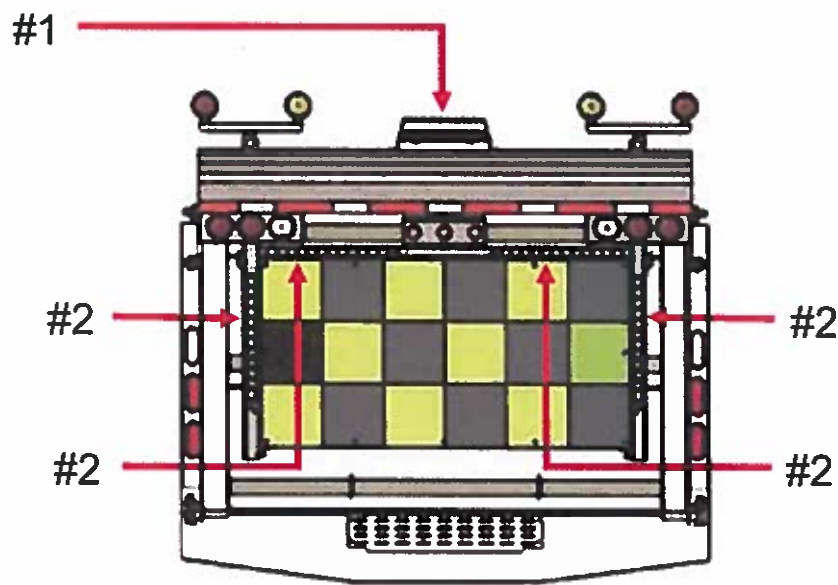

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Appendix A

Snow plow light placement



Rear View

#1 – rear facing light bar configured as either:

- i) flashes amber only,
- iii) flashes alternating amber and blue

#2 – four LED modules configured as either:

- i) all light modules alternate flashing amber,
- iii) each light module alternates flashing amber or blue
